Update on the 2-Stage Ditch

We have had quite a bit of interest in this project 1 mile north of Chrisney, IN, where the Alcoa Community Foundation-Funded project is making great progress. The 2-ditch was designed to hold a greater volume of water and help control flooding. It is expected to be completed by the end of summer. Heavy rains have caused some delays in construction. A field day is scheduled for Tuesday, September 20th from 8:00 am to 10:00 am where

various agencies will hold a joint-field day activity. The current panel of speakers will include representatives from the SWCD, ISDA, NRCS, and TNC (The Nature Conservancy).
