Special thanks to Amy Sims (ISDA) who helped our district with the event!

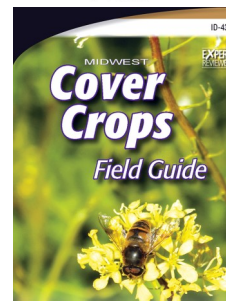
